Thank you for enquiring about our tile project. We appreciate your interest very much.

Currently our main focus is to raise money to restore the roof of the church, not an inconsiderable challenge. Our target is £130,000 (incl.VAT) which we hope to raise through a combination of fund raising events, individual donations and help from various charitable bodies by way of grants. We have achieved £40,000 ourselves by putting on many events, and by generous donations – some through our tile project.

People have chosen to write tiles to celebrate family events - baptisms, weddings, coming of age etc, or in memory of someone who has died. At this special time, remembering the centenary of the First World War, some have dedicated a tile to the memory of a family hero or heroine. On a lighter note, we have one from visitors who were on a world tour, someone who celebrated singing in All Saints' choir sixty years ago and another saying how much joy there is to be found walking in Wytham Woods. One tile is covered with a child's drawings and there are many more from those who would like to leave a personal message in the roof for posterity, thus playing a part in preserving the church building for the future.

When the project is completed, we hope by Christmas 2015, a photographic record of the tiles will be on show in the church in order to show how much we value the generosity that helped us to achieve this major work.

The donation for sponsoring a large tile is £30, small £10. There are two ways in which messages can be written on to the tile – either by us, following a postal/emailed request giving the appropriate wording, or by the donor writing the message themselves at the church, by prior arrangement with me. The messages are written in black marker pen. When composing your message, please bear in mind the tile size. As they are natural stone, size varies but approximately, large are 40x20cm, small 25x17cm.

Please accompany your request with a cheque made out to **All Saints', Wytham PCC**, to begin the process. Please do not hesitate to contact me, as above, if you wish further details.
